1. Review of Minutes and Actions from previous meeting

1.1. Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

1.2. Actions

003: Provide cost estimate for review.

Update: DA anticipated the implementation cost to be between £150-£250k, plus operational costs. GE asked if Xoserve were not involved in validating the claim how this would affect the costs. **Carried Forward**

004: Provide draft legal text for review. **Update:** BF confirmed legal text had been provided. **Complete**

005: Consider the questions/observations raised by Ofgem and provide a response to Ofgem and Workgroup 0429.

Update: GE confirmed that a response had been provided to Ofgem, giving a brief summary and that the modification had been updated to reflect any changes. **Complete**

2. Discussion

<u>Costs</u>

Following the consideration of costs, MC enquired if the operational per charge costs required estimated by Xoserve could be a service provided by the Shipper expert rather than Xoserve.

DA confirmed that Xoserve could provide an indication of its likely costs to administer the claim. Having discussed this with the proposer it was envisaged that an initial cost to validate the claim would be useful to ensure the Shipper could see some benefit in pursuing its claim. GE believed that Xoserve was only required to provide cursory validation of the claim and not necessarily validating the likely value/cost/length of a claim. However, this would be considered and clarified. SM felt that where a valid claim is submitted, then there is a debate to be had to what extent Xoserve would be validating that claim.

MC asked if commercial contracts could back off disputes with customer errors.

GE summarised the likely errors; explaining that this process is about mitigating the losses, it is unlikely a Shipper would be able to recover its full costs such as administration, margin etc.

Legal Text

GE confirmed there would be some changes/clarity required to the legal text, including where the charges sit.

Amended Modification

GE briefly explained the recent changes, it was noted that the summary section had not been updated inadvertently in relation to Section 6 – Implementation. It was agreed to correct the summary so it is inline with Section 6.
