#### 2.0 Workgroup Report

The Workgroup considered the amended business rules. A number of amendments were discussed and agreed in particular the reference to duplicate supply points on supplier portfolios and whether clarity was required within the business rule or if a definition was required. It was agreed to amend the business rule to make it clear this related to the double reporting of a supply points by different suppliers and not duplicates on the supply point register.

The Workgroup considered the Workgroup Report and agreed to undertake a number of amendments, which were recorded within the draft Workgroup Report.

The workgroup considered the self-governance status, based on discussions the Workgroup was of the opinion that the modification should not be treated as self-governance. In particular the Workgroup felt that the registration elements of the modification could materially impact Shippers. The Workgroup wished to invite the Panel

to agree the Self-Governance Statement should be withdrawn based on the criteria that there is a material impact on competition.

The Workgroup reviewed the Legal Text and provided Scotia Gas Networks with some points for consideration and suggested amendments.

It was agreed to reconsider the Modification, business rules, legal text and Workgroup Report at the next meeting.
