1.0 Outline of Modification and initial discussion

GE introduced the modification to extend the life of the DMV regime in theory by reintroducing DMV.

2.0 Initial Discussion

SM recognised the aspirations of DME. However, in the absence of a usable DME regime, DM mandatory sites that fall below the threshold should be allowed to continue as DMV until Nexus resolves the issue.

AM agreed that there should be very little consequence of maintaining the status quo for a longer than anticipated period. However, what is the consequence if the DMV regime is not extended. GE clarified this would result in less accurate allocation.

SM expressed the preference to discuss a suite of DM related modifications collectively as he was aware that a number of similar modifications were going to be raised. SM explained discussions have taken place within the Nexus Workgroup relating the Daily Metered regime and the use of Products 1 and 2.

GE also wished to discuss the Threshold crosser modification where Transporter meter reading equipment is on site but the site falls below the threshold out of DM mandatory to DME/DMV – post Nexus will there be a requirement to fit Shipper equipment to the site, if so how quickly.
