1.0 Outline of Modification

SM introduced the modification and explained its purpose.

2.0 Discussion

It was noted that the Code Governance Final Proposals had now been issued and the modification would be aligned to reflect these requirements.

ET sought clarification as to why the last paragraph on page 3 of the modification had been included. SM referred to licence condition SSC9.11(c) that allows the Authority to direct that an alternative should not be raised. ET believed that it

should be at the Authority's discretion and that this should be clarified. RH indicated that legal text needed to be developed and discussed.

CW asked if the SCR ruling needed to be changed. RH pointed out that the intent of this modification is only to put in place the Licence requirements; other issues could be addressed separately. It was suggested that the fast track modification process might be better addressed as a separate modification; SM indicated that it had broad industry support and could be reviewed in a month's time.

JCx believed there was no need to rush this modification but it would helpful to tidy it up. SM observed that Ofgem might think that it needs to have it implemented before October before the EU commitments. RH suggested it would be good to have it in place, as it will reflect the Licence; it may/may not include the fast track process – if this was too complex it might be separated out for individual development.

The relevant objectives were considered and it was agreed that (c) and (g) were facilitated.

Next Steps

JCx pointed out that it was important to have meeting papers issued in good time so parties could review and comment. RH confirmed that the legal text would be provided as soon as possible; he would like comments in advance so that if necessary the text could be revised and resubmitted for the May meeting.

The revised modification and the legal text were to be provided for review at the next meeting (02 May 2013), with a view to considering and completing a Workgroup Report.
