DA provided a presentation considering the current and potential process. CW explained the purpose of the modification, to allow the use of different equipment and bring the regime up to date to build in efficiencies.

GE highlighted that within Supplier licence 12 paragraphs 20 – 25 covers the ability to provide hourly data.

CB expressed concerned that this potential change was not discussed in Project Nexus and questioned the timing of changes for read submissions and impacts to settlement. She believed the modification went much further than simplifying the daily read submission.

CW explained that the modification considered the read timescales, performance and would enable the use of more varied and modern equipment. CW wished to work with Shippers to understand the challenges faced. He clarified that it is not intended to unbundle the Class 1 regime.

CW was keen to move forward and engage Shippers to continue to provide a service on more equitable grounds. He welcomed views from Shippers on what would and wouldn't work.

GE asked if there is opportunity for a provision/mechanism for reads earlier in the day rather than later in the day.

CW encouraged Shippers/Suppliers to provide evidence of what they currently do with their DM Reads and what timelines are involved and whether or not these are process specific requirements for them at the next meeting See Action 1101.
