1.0 Outline of Modification

CW introduced the modification and explained its rationale. It was believed prudent to produce guidelines for the Customer Settlement Error Claims Process to be governed by the UNC. The guidelines were being introduced simply for additional clarity to the rules set out in the UNC. This was in response to Ofgem's recommendations in their decision letter for Modification 0429

CB enquired about the difference between Ancillary and UNC related documents. BF explained the governance for UNC related documents, which require Uniform Network Code Committee approval.

2.0 Initial Discussion

DA confirmed that the guidelines are in the process of being finalised for consideration by the Workgroup and implementation by 01 April 2014.

SM expressed that the guidelines should not to cut across the Legal Text for Modification 0429. It was acknowledged that the Workgroup would have to review the guidelines to ensure there are no conflicts with the Legal Text.

It was anticipated that the guidelines and the legal text would be available for consideration at the next meeting and will be published as soon as possible.

CB was keen to ensure that the guidelines were not to be rushed to meet an artificial implementation date. Recent experience with other guidelines had shown highlighted conflicts with Code if care is not taken.
