The Workgroup Report is due to be presented at the UNC Modification Panel on 17 April 2014.

1.0 Outline of Modification

Opening, BF explained that confirmation of the Proposer's absence at today's meeting was only communicated to him late on the previous day, hence there was no time to cancel the meeting.

2.0 Initial Discussion

BF conducted a brief on-screen review of the modification whilst providing some background to the February Panel discussions on the matter.

DA advised that development costs are not anticipated to be material in nature as they are expected to fall in the lower end of the Xoserve scale and ongoing costs are expected to yield a net difference of zero (£0), excluding any allowance for retrospection. He then went on to add that he was surprised to see an element of retrospection included within the modification and believes that the Workgroup would need to find a view on this in due course.

Moving on, DA explained that Xoserve are fast becoming 'workload constrained' and inclusion of retrospective elements only serves to potentially double their workload, especially when bearing in mind, the proposed 2014 implementation date. When asked, DA confirmed that Xoserve had not yet had an opportunity to discuss their retrospection related concerns with the Proposer, M Clark ScottishPower.

MJ advised that he had discussed the question of retrospection with M Clark who had indicated that perhaps the retrospection elements could / would be removed in due course.

BF advised that the February UNC Panel had formally requested legal text to accompany the modification, which Wales & West Utilities are expected to provide in due course. However, should the modification be tweaked (to possibly remove retrospective elements etc.), then the legal text would also need to be amended accordingly.

The Workgroup concluded that in the absence of the Proposer and Wales & West Utilities it was very difficult to progress matters any further. BF advised that he would update M Clark, ScottishPower of the discussions undertaken in due course.

In closing, a new action was placed on all parties to review the modification and provide any thoughts/comments in time for further consideration at the next meeting.
