2.0 Discussion

AMa advised that he would like to put development of this modification on hold until the independent study had reported. AMi questioned this, arguing that some aspects of it could be developed independently and the opportunity to do that should be taken. This led onto a discussion about the invoicing process and the underlying principle of an incentive charge, which was a similar process to that used for the energy invoice. When asked if the modification would require a unique invoicing system to be developed rather than using the existing, AMi advised that it would not be appropriate to utilise the current process.

AL voiced her concerns over an apparent inconsistency between the way in which certain principles were accepted when proposed by Transporters but not when put forward by Shippers. AMi replied that the instance being referred to was for USRVs and the use of a convenient process to resolve an issue some time ago when Transco was the only

operator. BF looked to the proposer to give some thought to the possible invoicing options.

AMa said he originally regarded this process as being a neutrality pot that would be administered by Xoserve. CW suggested that similar work in this area had been undertaken on a number of previous modifications, so researching these could be of value. AMa asked NA if the model being developed by Engage would look at incentives but she replied that it was limited to risk and this was something for the workgroup. It was noted that the party causing the risk should be included in the incentive process.

AMa agreed to continue to develop section 4 of the modification dealing with invoicing and to report back to the next workgroup meeting.
