1.0 Outline of Modification

PL introduced the modification, explaining the purpose and intent, and describing the solution.

2.0 Initial Discussion

It was noted that this modification in its draft form had been considered and discussed at previous EU Workgroup meetings.

The processing of nominations and re-nominations was illustrated. JCx commented that the re-nominations lead times appeared to be much worse than was currently the case. CS confirmed that discussions with the adjacent TSOs were continuing; potentially the confirmed quantity could be sent out within 90 minutes. Once system development progresses it may be found to be quicker, but this could not be confirmed at present, and the generic/worst case has to be reflected in the modification. Once in place it may be found to work much more quickly in practice and is very likely to be less than the prescribed timescales in the modification. When concluded CS will bring the results of the TSO discussions to the Workgroup.

PL gave an overview of single and double-sided nominations processing. CS explained that the Initiator and Matching roles were under discussion with the TSOs; whichever is eventually assigned would be enduring. National Grid NTS would prefer to have a standardised role for its three IPs.

DS highlighted concerns regarding the loss of flexibility in moving from hourly to daily nominations. PL confirmed that daily nominations were proposed and discussions were ongoing in relation to how to compare/match hourly information received to daily information.

A question was asked regarding progress on Moffat, and whether it was a 2 or 3 TSO party. MH replied that the Moffat point remained as is and capacity would be offered in the same manner as the new Bacton IP utilising PRISMA to offer capacity with more than one TSO on the other side.

It was inquired when the industry would have more clarity. MH and LM (Ofgem) stated that discussions were ongoing with the TSOs and NRAs concerned and were moving closer to a resolution. CS added that it was hoped that these would be concluded within the lifetime of this modification.

LM indicated that a consultation on the splitting of Bacton was likely in the next month or so, ie how CAM will be implemented and how it affects entry/exit onto the NTS, and will lead to a licence modification relating to the splitting of Bacton. The booking of exit capacity at Moffat is not likely to change.

Next Steps

JC indicated that Shippers would welcome advanced sight of the Gemini screens that are being proposed for use. CS responded that Chris Gumbley (National Grid NTS) was intending to attend the next meeting on 22 May with an update, and perhaps would be able to provide more detail to give an early insight.

PL will provide Draft Business Rules for discussion at the next meeting.
