**0504** – Noting that, for expediency, this was ahead of its presentation to the Modification Panel on 19 June, LJ confirmed that a meeting had been arranged for 02 July 2014; concerns were expressed that a number of Shippers may not be able to attend on this date and an alternative might be preferred. DRa noted these concerns for consideration.

#### 1.3 Ofgem Update

DR provided a general update as follows:

- Stakeholder Engagement Panel Members 2013-14. The Stakeholder Engagement Incentive is intended to encourage network companies to engage effectively with a wide range of stakeholders to inform how they plan and run their businesses. - Scotia Gas Network's decision to proceed with alternative LNG as the short term solution for supplying the Statutory Independent Undertakings (SIUs). The additional cost of supplying LNG to the SIUs is recovered through a charge levied by National Grid Gas Transmission on all shippers and then passed on from NGG to Scotia Gas Networks (SGN). Observing that this had been an ongoing issue for the past seven years, NR asked how short-term was the 'short-term' solution. In the absence of any alternatives, it was conceded that this was a less expensive solution than laying pipe.

- Uniform Network Code (UNC) 491: Change Implementation Date of Project Nexus to 1 April 2016. UNC491 sought to delay the implementation of Project Nexus until 1 April 2016 or such other later date as may be determined by the Uniform Network Code Committee (UNCC).
