The Workgroup Report is due to be presented at the UNC Modification Panel by 20 August 2015.

1.0 Outline of Modification

MH introduced the modification, explaining the background and its purpose.

GJ asked whether consideration had been given to extending this to all ASEPs. MH explained that requests for the amendment had been received from Irish parties due to the smaller nature of connected loads on their networks and this proposed change had been raised only to ensure compliance under the 3rd Package for the imminent implementation. National Grid NTS recognised that the principle could be extended to all GB ASEPs but felt that more consideration of the wider issues and likely system changes would be necessary. DR questioned whether it facilitated relevant objective (g), and MH explained the focus on TSO/TSO co-operation; because of the timing lag in receiving Irish feedback it had not been included in previous modifications. MH added that National Grid NTS would be happy to work with other industry parties to develop modifications seeking to extend this to other ASEPs, noting that this might potentially require a long lead time to look at system developments, etc.
