AC provided a brief update on the data compiled following the initial trial that concluded earlier in the week. He explained that 100 sites had been selected at random from the circa 18k sites that have not been read in the last 3 to 4 years and these were sent to G4S for investigation.

In summary, reads were obtained for 49 sites (out of the 100) and these have been passed to Xoserve for assessment. Those sites where no read has been collected tend to reflect instances where no access was attained, or no appointment time/date was available etc.

Whilst AC now expects to provide a more (high level) comprehensive report at the next Workgroup meeting, more detailed breakdowns on impacted parties respective sites would be provided to them in due course.
