4.1 Xoserve Review - Ofgem Update

JCa gave a presentation, outlining the background to the review and giving an update on progress towards implementing the new arrangements.

Reference was made to the role of the newly convened Change Overview Board (COB). This had no formal responsibilities under Code governance but will be reviewing industry change priorities. Its views could feed into Xoserve's business planning and it has the potential to be a useful industry discussion forum and provide a good opportunity to engage with stakeholders.

Clarity on timescales for Licence changes was sought. April 2015 had been proposed but this may not now be feasible and, depending on consultation responses, would be reviewed.

Funding arrangements were queried. The GTs will cover the costs of Xoserve and at an appropriate point Ofgem will review against what has been delivered and see what has been covered; there was a possibility some funding can be removed if projects are not delivered. MB added there would be a regular assessment of outputs against funding and who pays what over what timeframe will be worked through. The governance funding review should not impact delivery of projects. The Change Overview Board (COB) had discussed EU Codes and Project Nexus priorities and would be sending a letter to Ofgem shortly. LJ drew attention to the Joint Office website at www.gasgovernance.co.uk/COB, where COB meeting papers will be made available.

JCh suggested that regular updates on the delivery of Xoserve's project plans would be welcome.
