3. Issues

All live Issues are due to be considered at a dedicated Distribution Workgroup meeting on Monday 28 November 2011.

GE explained that the MPRN creation issue was raised to look at unregistered sites. He anticipates a modification being raised by the end of the month to take this forward – and any thoughts on this would be welcome. The modification would be looking to incentivise the resolution of sites without a Shipper. In particular, the modification would propose that Transporters be given an obligation to take responsibility for unregistered sites – sites that remain without a Shipper after six months. If no Shipper is in place, any right to offtake gas would cease to exist.

CW questioned what Transporters would be expected to do after six months, bearing in mind they have no association with the end user. GE explained that the site will be known and, if offtaking gas, should either be registered to a Shipper, or the Transporter could become responsible for any gas usage as an alterative to

disconnecting the meter concerned – and Transporters could then bill for the gas used, or could adopt any other process they care to implement in response to the incentive.

AJe noted that there would be issues in defining the start of the six month period as circumstances vary, and MPRN creation date is not an absolute and consistent measure. RGMA flows may need to be considered and appropriate definitions incorporated within the modification. AJe emphasised that if a draft could be shared, Xoserve would endeavour to support the proposer and provide thoughts on implementation aspects of the modification.
