Mod 280 – Demand Estimation Review

Issues with current processes:

- 1. Mismatch between responsibility for process (Transporters) and impacts from accuracy (Shippers)
- 2. Current process has ability to amend seasonal normal based on a view that is not agreed by industry experts
- 3. DESC is usually accepted as an expert group but has no ability to influence output
- 4. DESC has no voting rights or ability to manage the processes this should be reflected in formal voting and a review of membership rights
- 5. Very limited visibility of the analysis
- 6. No view of the data or the time to actively challenge and rework analysis
- 7. Ability to replicate and verify the methodology (by being able to reproduce the published numbers using the agreed methodology) in order to internally audit the process should the need arise
- 8. Consultation processes as currently defined do not constitute a real and effective consultation
- 9. Transporters process for undertaking analysis is not transparent needs to be clear who is undertaking the analysis to prevent any potential conflicts with other areas of responsibility
- 10. Output from demand estimation process impacts AQ significantly and should therefore allow everyone to have a say some form of sign off process?
- 11. Seasonal normal dispute highlighted the lack of dispute mechanisms and an effective mechanism should be designed
