Mod Title: Performance Assurance Reporting

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Why change?

- Modification 520 was raised by British Gas to introduce performance reporting into network code, to remove anonymity from performance reports and to help the introduction of Performance Assurance Arrangements under the code.
- The Gas Transporters through their agent currently provide some reports to assist the industry in monitoring their own performance, however this modification is formalising some of that reporting and builds on it with Project Nexus in sight.
- The reports take account of risks identified in the Engage Settlement Risk Assessment Study, details of which can be found here: http://www.gasgovernance.co.uk/pa/IndRiskStudy

Options

- As this is an alternate, there are a number of proposed reports that have been presented and which have had limited discussion at the Performance Assurance Workgroup.
- The initial modification requires the Gas Transporters to publicise these performance reports on the internet – which would then make them widely available in their raw state without the benefit of any narrative or context; the alternate makes the performance monitoring reports available only to UNC parties and for use in the Performance Assurance Framework that is under development.

Solution

- This alternate modification codifies some existing reports that are available pre-Nexus which need to have anonymity removed, and
- It end-dates those that are not appropriate for a post Nexus implementation, and
- It creates a second schedule for Post Nexus reporting.

Recommended Steps

- The Proposer recommends that this modification should be:
 - Proceed to Workgroup assessment to be developed alongside the original.
