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# **Summary**

#### Is this a Self-Governance Modification?

Scotia Gas Networks believes that this modification should be a self-governance modification because:

- (i) it is unlikely to have a material effect on any of the following:
  - (a) existing or future gas consumers; and
  - (b) competition in the shipping, transportation or supply of gas conveyed through pipes or any commercial activities connected with the shipping, transportation or supply of gas conveyed through pipes; and
  - (c) the operation of one or more pipe-line system(s); and
  - (d) matters relating to sustainable development, safety or security of supply, or the management of market or network emergencies; and
  - (e) the uniform network code governance procedures or the network code modification procedures; and
- (ii) it is unlikely to discriminate between different classes of parties to the uniform network code/relevant gas transporters, gas shippers or DN operators.

#### Is this a Fast Track Self-Governance Modification?

We believe that this modification is a Fast Track Self-Governance Modification as it seeks purely to reinstate a measurement within legal text previously used but amended accidentally through a previous UNC modification.

The modification:

- would meet the self-governance criteria; and
- is properly a housekeeping modification required as a result of some error or factual change, including but not limited to:
  - i. updating names or addresses listed in the uniform network code;
  - ii. correcting minor typographical errors;
  - iii. correcting formatting and consistency errors, such as paragraph numbering; or
  - iv. updating out of date references to other documents or paragraphs.

## Why Change?

This change is required to amend TPD Section G 2.5.8(b). The change plans to reinstate the measure of Calendar Days into this section of the UNC. This change is required as UNC modification 0463S accidentally amended this to Supply Point Business Days which must now be corrected.

### Solution

The change is required to amend the reference in TPD Section G 2.5.8(b) from Supply Point System Business Days to Calendar Days.

#### **Relevant Objectives**

The modification will have a positive effect on relevant objective (f); promotion of efficiency in the implementation and administration of the code.

## **Implementation**

The modification could be implemented 16 business days after a vote in favour of implementation by the Modification Panel. No implementation costs are expected.

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# 2 Why Change?

The change is required to amend TPD Section G 2.5.8(b). The change plans to reinstate the measure of calendar days into this section of the legal text to reverse an error created during the implementation of Modification 0463S.

## 3 Solution

This modification seeks to amend TPD Section G 2.5.8(b) by removing Supply Point Systems Business Day from the legal text and replacing it with Calendar Days as previously used in Modification 0403.

## **User Pays**

- (b) not less than 20 <u>calendar</u> <u>Supply Point Systems Business Dd</u>ays commencing on the Day after the Supply Point Confirmation is submitted unless:
