# Mod 599 - Amendments to CAM to comply with EU Capacity Regulations (Interruptible)

- Mod 599 proposes a restriction on day ahead interruptible capacity.
- NGG currently offers interruptible capacity on a day ahead basis, based on the UNC UIOLI calculation. NGG may also offer discretionary interruptible capacity on a day ahead basis. Mod 599 proposes that, for IPs only, interruptible capacity will only be made available where firm capacity is sold out day-ahead or not offered.
- This Modification was based on 15<sup>th</sup> September version of CAM prior to comitology. Following comitology the final CAM text changed to the following:

*As from 1 January 2018, transmission system operators may only offer standard capacity products for interruptible capacity of a duration longer than one day if the corresponding monthly, quarterly or yearly standard capacity product for firm capacity was sold at an auction premium, was sold out, or was not offered.*

*Transmission system operators shall **only** offer a daily capacity product for interruptible capacity in both directions at interconnection points where the respective standard capacity product for firm capacity was sold out day ahead or was not offered. “*
