Transporter Members had concerns that in the event of high demand a considerable strain may be placed on resources and impact efficiency but, excepting this, agreed that implementation of the Proposal could be expected to further the GT Licence 'code relevant objective' of 'securing effective competition between relevant shippers and between relevant suppliers'.

Transporter Members wished it to be minuted that only a low level of service could be supported as there would not be a fully systematised solution. The Panel then voted UNANIMOUSLY to recommend implementation of the Proposal.
