Some Panel Members considered that implementation of the Modification Proposal could be expected to further the GT Licence 'code relevant objectives' of 'facilitating effective competition between relevant Shippers' and 'promotion of efficiency in the implementation and administration of the code', whereas others did not believe this to be the case.

The Panel then voted and of the seven Members present, capable of casting ten votes, five votes were cast in favour of implementation, P Broom (Gaz de France), S Ladle (Total Gas and Power), S Rouse (Statoil) and M Young (British Gas Trading) who also had a proxy vote for C Sykes (EON UK). Therefore the Panel did not recommend implementation.
