

Unique Sites Scope – Deferral Impact

Unique sites which will be deferred are:

- All NTS sites including Direct Connect sites, Connected System Operator (CSO) sites and Shared Supply Meter Points
- NTS Interconnectors
- LDZ Telemetered sites
- LDZ Connected System Operator (CSO) sites
- LDZ Direct Connect sites with NTS Optional Rate and/or LDZ Optional Rate
- LDZ Shared Supply Meter Points
- LDZ Site Specific Calorific values (CV)
- LDZ Sites with any Special Metering Arrangements in place.

Unique Sites Scope – Deferral Impact

Where a site changes between being a Single to a Shared Supply Meter Point and visa versa the following process will occur:

- NTS Sites – Will remain offline until Implementation
- LDZ Sites – Will transfer from SAP ISU to offline whilst the site is set up as a Shared Supply Meter Point.

As part of MOD428 where sites no longer require to be administered offline, work will be carried out to transfer these back to On-line.
