RIIO Innovation Review. On <u>24 October 2016</u> we published the minutes of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority meeting which took place on <u>15 September 2016</u>. The review of the RIIO innovation schemes was on the agenda. The emerging conclusions suggested that benefits were likely to be a significant multiple of the costs, although it was noted that the cost-benefit analysis was based on network companies' own estimates of future benefits, tested for reasonableness by external consultants.
