**Certification decision on GNI(UK) Limited.** On 4<sup>th</sup> April 2016 Ofgem published its final decision that GNI(UK) should be certified as independent and that it is designated as a gas TSO. Proposal to modify Gas Transporters Licence Standard Condition 2. Consultation: Responses required by 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2016. On 9<sup>th</sup> March 2016, Ofgem published a consultation document proposing to modify Standard Condition 2 of the Gas Transporters Licence to remove any impression that the Authority would need the consent of the licensee to undertake certain actions. The proposed modifications would mean that this licence condition would be compliant with the requirements of the Gas Directive 2009/73/EC, which requires that the Authority be able to make independent decisions.
