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Refining the Vulnerable Customer Needs Codes Priority Service Register (PSR)

Overview

- Ofgem have made a decision to modify the gas and electricity supply, electricity distribution and gas transporter licenses for PSR arrangements
- As part of these changes, there is an expectation that more accurate and efficient sharing of customer vulnerability information between the energy sector will be delivered.
- Ofgem envisaged this will be facilitated by using revised 'Needs Category Descriptions' as developed by the Safe Guarding Customers Workgroup.
- To facilitate this, there are currently three changes within SPAA covering at least one of the below points:
 - Implementation of new needs category descriptions and numbering
 - Mapping of existing needs category descriptions to new needs category descriptions
 - Implementation of governance rules



Current Status

- Change proposal's 16/370, 16/370A and 16/370B are currently issued for industry consultation.
- Consultation closes on 10th April 2017.
- As a result of consultation responses proposers may wish to make amendments to solutions and proposed implementation dates considering industry feedback.
 - Please note there is a dependency on UKLP implementation and stability which may impact change proposal implementation timescales.
