Dear Colleague,

I refer to Transco's proposal as presented at yesterdays UNC Distribution Workstream which relates to metering arrangements at Primary 'check' meters.

You may be aware that these are referred to within the UNC Section G1.8.1(e)(iii) as being 'a meter is a check meter where all gas which flows through the meter also flows through one or more meters (in such arrangement) downstream of that meter'. These are commonly referred to as being Primary 'analytical' meters.

Following discussion, it was identified that a pre-requisite to progressing the matter was that the number of such meters existing should be understood. Shippers were therefore asked by Transco to advise of the number of such meters within their individual portfolios.

I would be grateful if relevant numbers (and any supporting information which you believe could be useful) could be passed either to the Joint Office or to myself at the e-mail address below by <u>13 October 2005</u>. Following collation of the information by Transco, this will facilitate further discussion at the UNC Distribution Workstream scheduled for 27th October 2005.
