Farningham Meter anomaly

But also

- Developments since Mod Review Group 643
- Anomalies are never the same
- Need for flexibility
- Desire to have a codified process
- Legal Issues

Objective is to raise a UNC Mod reflecting on findings of review group

BACKGROUND

Mod Review Proposal 643 suggests the following process should be followed if reconciliation greater than 50GWh or £1m :

- RbD Shippers given a minimum of 15 days notice prior to invoice release**
- Shippers have 5 business days to respond – if no response reconciliation takes place**
- Operations & Trading have 5 business days to respond to Shipper queries**
- Shippers have 5 further days to respond – if no response reconciliation takes place**
- BOF scheduled with vote on reconciliation. 1 vote in favour proceed to reconcile, if unanimous opposition proceed to expert determination**
