Notice issued to industry via Joint Office of Gas Transporters, Transco proposes implementation of this Modification with effect from 1 October 2005.

Requirements for Implementation

- 1. Ancillary document ‘*Schedule for Shipper Communications in Incidents of CO Poisoning, Gas Fire/Explosions and Local Gas Supply Emergency*’**
 - To be incorporated into the document T/PR/E3 ‘**Operational Procedure for Gas Supply Emergencies**’.
 - updated Gas Supply Emergency documents (Transco/E/1, Transco/E/2 and T/PR/E3) become effective for all Networks from 1 October 2005.
 - Schedule issued for review – responses issued where appropriate.
 - Anticipated issue of final document by the end of July 2005 (depending on iDN take up of web site use).
- 2. A method of delivering the required communications from the proposed implementation date.**

Delivering Communications (1)

- **NGT will deliver communications via a web based Incident Reporting System.**
- **Currently reviewing UNC requirements in respect of 'Code Communications.**
- **The system has recently been through a programme of User Acceptance Testing.**
- **It is intended to 'parallel run' the system alongside the current reporting methods prior to the implementation date of 1 October 2005.**

Delivering Communications (2)

- **NGT has offered iDNs the use of its web based Incident Reporting System.**
- **NGT has scheduled a demonstration of the Incident Reporting System for interested iDNs on Wednesday 20th July at NGT House Warwick, starting at 10.30am.**
- **Invitation issued on 20 June 2005 and expanded to all iDNs regardless of interest expressed or otherwise.**

Conclusion

- NGT confident it can meet an implementation date of 1 October 2005.
- NGT has offered iDNs the use an Incident Reporting System which if utilised will deliver the information via a common platform.
