Early Closure of Annual Invitation to Participate in Auction of Quarterly System Entry Capacity

In accordance with paragraph B2.2.19 of the UNC, National Grid plc has closed the Annual Invitation for Quarterly System Entry Capacity early. This has occurred because the Stability Groups (as determined in accordance with section B2.2.17 of the UNC) that changed between the first Interim Bid Window held on Monday 14th September and the second Interim Bid Window held on Tuesday 15th September were one.

The final allocation will be determined by application of the tests described in National Grid plc's Incremental Entry Capacity Release (IECR) statement.

National Grid plc will inform Users of their QSEC capacity allocation within Gemini (via the bid information screen) no later than two calendar months after the last annual invitation date and therefore, at the latest by 10th November 2009.

- Revenue from sales of Baseline, Obligated Incremental and Non-Obligated Incremental capacity
- Amount of unallocated Baseline Capacity
- Clearing Price (This will be the same as the highest, lowest and weighted average prices)
- The number of Users who submitted successful capacity bids

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- The number of Users who submitted unsuccessful capacity bids
- Where there is an allocation of QSEC in a period number of Users who submitted bids at each price level
