We believe that this Modification will provide more flexibility for Users to reduce Enduring NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity holdings.

Building on the principles established by Modification 0417S, 0439 will treat capacity with no User Commitment in the same way as capacity that is subject to user commitment, and therefore will remove any concerns of preferential treatment being conferred on the latter category.
