Modification 0477 introduced faster switching, which reduced industry timescales to process AQ data. Considering Capacity bookings and Transportation charges are derived from AQ data, we support the requirement for industry down time to allow the Transporter Agency time to complete the AQ updates and ensure the correct AQ data is calculated and provided to shippers.

Modification 580S originally proposed four AQ non-effective days. Through development the non-effective period was extended to seven days to align it with the Nexus non-effective period. Considering the Ofgem consultation to potentially delay Nexus, we believe it is appropriate for this modification to return back to workgroup for further development. Following Ofgem's Nexus consultation decision, which is expected at the end of June, the workgroup are able to better align the non-effective period to a Xoserve business requirement, rather than to another project.

As the non-effective period could have a delay to a customer transfer, this additional time period could have a material impact to customer switching dates. As a result we do not believe this is proposal meets the self governance criteria.
