Whilst we understand that National Grid's sale of its Distribution Network has resulted in multiple invoicing changes for shippers and these costs have had to absorb by them and their customers, we also understand that post Nexus Modification 0606 is the most variable solution which will maintain a combined invoice which is subsequently split and re-invoiced using Ad hoc invoicing.
