Corona Energy support this modification as it will remove the uncertainty of whether opening meter reads for customer submitted after D+7 but up to D+10 will be accepted by Xoserve. Providing certainty that an opening meter reading will be accepted by Xoserve up to D+10 provides more time to obtain an accurate meter reading for a new customer. Reducing the number of estimated opening reads will reduce the number of system corrections that need to be progressed by Shippers to reflect site consumption and improve the accuracy of customer bills.
