Implementation of UNC modification 0345 removes the DMV (Daily Metered Voluntary) service from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2014 and these sites will either have the option to be reclassified as NDM or DME (Daily Metered Elective). DME regime is not a viable solution due to the deadlines for submitting daily readings. The changes required to make the DME regime a workable solution would not be cost effective as Project Nexus which is due to be implemented Q4 2015 would give the DME regime a limited duration.

Extending the DMV service will allow the existing DMV sites to remain daily settled rather than being settled on estimates, which provides accurate gas allocation costs. Extending the DMV service will also provide a seamless transition into the Project Nexus settlement products and is therefore a more efficient and cost effective solution.
