As a combined heat and power station, our gas usage is dictated by market conditions. These changed market conditions have had the effect of reducing our gas requirement this year, and peak value is anticipated to remain below the level of last year; the use of the BSSOQ in our case has the effect of forcing us to book an overcapacity with attendant transportation costs which need to be absorbed or passed on. If the BSSOQ could be challenged, a more accurate gas requirement would be made, with the transportation charge levied against that volume.
