We believe that one of the principle benefits of Nexus was the delivery of a more accurate and agile AQ regime which was able to reflect consumption changes as they occur, resulting in a closer relationship between the gas actually used by customers and the gas allocated under current rules, reducing gas "purchase v sales" cost differences which ultimately finds its way into customer prices. This proposal offers the protection from spurious readings being used within the AQ calculation as the Rolling AQ regime begins. It will enable customers to benefit from Rolling $A Q$ as soon as qualifying reads permit whilst protecting the market from foreseeable error.
