EDF Energy supports the implementation of UNC Modification 0467 because it presents an opportunity of creating consistent data between the independent gas transporters and the GDNs which is crucial to ensure the accuracy of energy allocation across the gas network. If data is not cleansed and prepared prior to migration into the new UK Link system proposed under Project Nexus then this will adversely impact the new processes going forward and so lead to a reduction of the perceived benefits of the new settlements regime. This Modification will ensure that if UNC Modification 0440 and IGT UNC Modification 039 are implemented on 1st October 2015 then it will create an efficient starting point of Single Service Provision to allow iGT meter points to be treated like directly connected meter points. Good quality data will also help with the rollout of smart metering by ensuring that there is consistent data across central systems.
