Abstract:

GDF SUEZ is strongly supportive of:

- double-sided nomination for bundled capacity as well as unbundled capacity
- single-sided nomination for bundled capacity or in case of unbundled capacity if the same entity owns the capacity on both sides of the IP

Any restriction on these alternatives may really complicate the management of our nominations.

That's to say, the paragraph 54 of the draft modification report (p.21) should be updated the following way :

54. Nomination and Re-nomination of quantities against:
 - 54.1. Bundled Capacity products may be submitted via a Single Sided Nomination (the 'single nom concept').**[CAM 19(7)], or via Double Sided Nominations**
 - 54.2. Unbundled Capacity products should be submitted via Double Sided Nominations. [National Grid is in discussions with its Adjacent Transporters on the possible application of a Single Sided Nomination to Unbundled Capacity].

55. A User holding both Bundled Capacity and Unbundled Capacity at an IP may submit separate Single Sided Nominations and Double Sided Nominations respectively, **or double Sided Nominations for both Bundled and Unbundled Capacities.**
