## **OPPOSE IMPLEMENTATION**

Please summarise (in one paragraph) the key reason(s) for your support/opposition.

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We believe that Transporters should be able to report concerns relating to Meter Information to Shippers however the proposed modification allows the Transporter to be able to overwrite existing Meter Information held against a Registered Shipper.

The provision and responsibility for Meter Information does not rest with the Transporter, Shipper or Supplier but following meter unbundling is the responsibility of the relevant Meter Asset Manager and accordingly any changes to Meter Information should flow through the appropriate contractual route.

The ability for the Transporter to be able to unilaterally change data is not consistent with the unbundled metering market and the commercial relationship in place between the relevant Meter Asset Manager and the relevant Supplier.

Should Meter Information be changed unilaterally the Transporter is neutral to the impact should the update subsequently be found to be erroneous.
