0390: Introduction of a Supply Point Offtake Rate Review and Monitoring Process

Abstract:

The MEUC's view on UNC modification 0390 is that it should **NOT** be implemented.

The modification as drafted suggests a decision is made between the Transporter and Shipper, neither of who has a contractual relationship with the consumer.

The activity described should be carried out on an annual basis by the supplier and their customer as part of the annual contract review. A decision of whether to share this with the Transporter and shipper should be taken, however if the customer decides that they do not wish to amend any of the settings (SHQ, SOQ, AQ) this should be final, especially if the customer is prepared to pay for the capacity when it is often difficult to predict future demand for products or services from its own customers.
