### Do you support or oppose implementation?

# Please summarise (in one paragraph) the key reason(s) for your support/opposition.

National Grid Distribution (NGD) believes that this Modification Proposal usefully clarifies the arrangements under which National Grid Transmission (NTS) undertakes the activity of daily calorific value determination on behalf the Distribution Network Operators (DNOs). Implementation would remove a date from the current version of the UNC that is no longer relevant and implies that the NTS provision of the CV determination service has already terminated. The proposal looks to confirm that the service is an enduring one, while setting out a process and timescale by which either party may exit from the arrangement, should they wish to do so.

# Are there any new or additional issues that you believe should be recorded in the Modification Report?

We have not identified any such issues.

### **Self governance statement:**

Do you agree with the Modification Panel's decision that this should be a self-governance modification? This Modification Proposal facilitates the continuation of a service which is currently being undertaken to the satisfaction of all parties. NGD believes that implementation of this Proposal would not have any material impact on the current arrangements and can be implement without changing any party's current obligations.

#### **Relevant Objectives:**

How would implementation of this modification impact the relevant objectives?

The Proposal facilitates the relevant objective as set out within Standard Special Condition A11.1 (f): Promotion of efficiency in the implementation and administration of the Code. NGD believes that removing a date which has long since expired and clarifying the existing arrangements is consistent with this objective.

There would be no change to the prevailing arrangements. No additional costs would be incurred or analysis required.
