National Grid NTS support the principles of the Modification 401S. By applying the daily agreed pressure process to a reduced list of offtakes, through the creation of a Significant Offtake list, will help facilitate a more efficient process and reduce the admin burden for both Distribution Network Operators (DNO) and National Grid NTS. This modification also provides for a greater focus on the Offtakes that are believed to be the most significant from an operational perspective for both parties and may provide additional clarity in planning the operation of the respective networks.

National Grid NTS provided an initial representation which highlighted some initial concerns with the original draft modification regarding the relief of specific UNC provisions under certain scenarios. The proposer has since amended the modification and the relief of UNC provisions are no longer a feature of the modification. National Grid NTS welcomes the changes made by the proposer and as a result the concerns detailed within our initial representation with regards to this aspect are no longer applicable.
