On balance we support the implementation of this proposal.

We agree with the principle of the Modification that it is appropriate to retain the obligation on the last registered Shipper to resolve sites which have been subject to Effective Supply Point Withdrawal or Isolation but which remains capable of flowing gas.

However we also believe that to an extent the Proposal legitimises the shipper/supplier actions (or non-action) which generates "shipperless" sites and as such inadvertently perpetuates (and to an extent legitimises) a recognised inefficiency of the current regime, which we consider is contrary to the Relevant Objectives of securing effective competition between Shippers and between Suppliers and the efficient operation of the relevant transporter's system.
