BBL Company has requested changes to its Interconnection Agreement in respect of its Interconnection Point at Bacton. There are minor drafting errors which appear in the current Network Entry Provisions. Therefore a UNC 'enabling Modification' in accordance with UNC (ref.TPD I 2.2.3 (a)) is required seeking industry approval to make these minor amendments.

The changes required are purely redrafting and do not change the values or parameters of the Gas Entry Conditions or Measurement Provisions.
