After an industry consultation on proposed amendments, Ofgem directed a change to the gas DSR methodology on the 7<sup>th</sup> July 2016.

Consequently, UNC is no longer aligned with the gas DSR Methodology.

National Grid is obligated to implement the gas DSR Methodology through revisions to UNC, therefore these approved changes now need to be reflected in UNC.

#### **Self-Governance Statement:**

This modification should be subject to self-governance because it is enacting a consequential change to the gas DSR Methodology which has been approved by Ofgem, and therefore does not require further authorisation.

### Implementation:

We agree that this Modification Proposal can be implemented with immediate effect 16 business days after an approval decision by the UNC Modification Panel in August.
