As the proposer National Grid NTS fully supports the implementation of the Modification Proposal.

Modification Proposal 0597 seeks to ensure that the amended EU CAM Code is reflected into the UNC. The change would ensure alignment of EU Regulations (once introduced) for incremental capacity processes at GB IPs. This provides clarity and consistency between the Regulation and UNC.

National Grid NTS agrees with the statement on self-governance and supports the modification going to the Authority for approval.

No implementation date has been specified, however National Grid NTS notes the expected implementation date of the CAM Amendments is 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017, with the demand assessment commencing on the entry into force date. The earliest date this modification can be implemented\* is 1<sup>st</sup> April, however there is some uncertainty over this date due to internal Commission processes.

\*We understand that the entry into force date is between 26<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> March 2017 where the demand indication process would be introduced.
