Re: UNC Modification Proposal 0407 - Standardisation of notice periods for offtake rate changes for all National Grid NTS Exit Users

Thank you for the opportunity to provide representation of the above noted Modification Proposal. Northern Gas Networks (NGN) supports this Modification Proposal. Please find below NGN's comments in respect of the Modification Proposal.

# NGN supports this Modification proposal.

### Summary of key reasons:

NGN supports the implementation of this proposal. We have experienced similar issues to that of the proposer and note that it is not always possible to buffer for an increase in gas offtake for two hours before being able to increase or decrease our intake. This is due to the dynamics of the system and the time of day the deviation may take place.

We believe the 2 hour 5% rule is not rigorously applied by National Grid NTS even on very high demand days and as a result believe that it only offers a small benefit to National Grid NTS and is not required for the most part in any given Gas Year.

NGN acknowledge the analysis commissioned by National Grid NTS on the associated costs for implementing the proposal as it was originally put forward and agree that the prohibitive nature of these indicative costs meant that a compromise was require to facilitate occasions where permanent removal of the rule would have been detrimental. We therefore support the amended proposal as a sensible compromise between removal of the rule and its permanent application.
