This modification is positive against objective d) – effective competition between shippers. The more risk-reflective collateral will free up funds in summer months, enabling more effective competition at this time of year. In addition, it also supports competition by levelling out the impact of the current arrangement where shippers with inherently flatter load profiles are less affected. It achieves this without increasing the risk to the industry of financial loss from shipper default as users are still obliged to have enough collateral to cover their exposure at any given point in time.
