RWE npower recognises that this modification is needed to ensure a smooth transition of settlement arrangements to Project Nexus. We do however hold some concern that the finer details in some areas are yet to be agreed by the workgroup. This modification will also be impacted by Modification 0532, Implementation of Non-Effective days which is yet to be agreed.

The Transitional business rules that support this modification state that there will be no AQ Amendments after August 2015.
