SGN supports the proposed implementation of this modification as it seeks to give DNs increased flexibility in amending our aggregate offtake rates. The current 2 hour 5% rule has been shown historically to be unnecessary as even on high demand days NTS have not applied the rule.

We believe that a pragmatic approach has been taken in the development of this modification which seeks to benefit all parties involved. The alternative to this modification would have been to invest in additional storage on potentially both the NTS and DN systems to accommodate excursions outside of the 2 hour 5% rule. Analysis that was completed by the DNs indicated that localised storage to comply with the existing rules would cost in the region of £350 million and as such we believe that this modification provides an economical solution.
