SGN supports Modification 0606 as it

- provides certainty in the post-Nexus transitional invoicing arrangements for National Grid Gas plc and National Grid Gas Distribution Ltd;

We

- agree that the transitional arrangements should be in place from PNID until the earliest suitable subsequent release date, as determined by DSC Change Management Committee;
- believe it is appropriate for the DSC Change Management Committee to determine when these current transitional arrangements conclude.
